# Driving Acronyms

Cockpit drill

D – doors – check they are closed and secure

H - Handbrake on

**S** – **seat** – adjusted, left foot on clutch, not stretched or cramped – include head restraint

**S** – **steering** – able to move hands around wheel

S – seat belt – flat across chest and stomach

M – mirrors – adjusted to show out the rear and down the sides of car

moving off

**P** – **preparation** – check handbrake, in neutral, start engine, find bite, keep feet still, prepare handbrake but do not release (Pound coin)

**O** – **observation** – check centre mirror then do a 360 degree view, signal if necessary

**M** – **manoeuvre** – release handbrake, keep feet still, move off, cancel signal stopping changing direction

**M** – **mirror** – check mirrors before any change of speed, change of direction, approaching hazards, whilst driving

S – signal – correct, where necessary, properly timed

M – manoeuvre – whether turning, moving, overtaking or passing

#### Turning

**M** – **mirror** – check mirrors before change of speed, change of direction, approaching hazards, whilst driving

- S signal correct, where necessary, properly timed
- **P position** depending on the type of manoeuvre to be carried out
- **S speed** adjusted for the manoeuvre to be carried out
- L look checking mirrors, roads depending on manoeuvre

## Pulling out turning in

- L look look into the road you're entering, at the traffic approaching
- A assess whether it is safe to proceed
- **D decide** whether you can emerge safely
- A act act upon the above information

**O** – **observation** – take in all ahead of you - near, middle and far distance

W – without

## L – limits

Pulling out change of direction

- **S swerve** do not cause other drivers to swerve to avoid you
- **S slow** do not cause other drivers to slow down to avoid you
- **S stop** do not cause other drivers to stop to avoid you

#### General

**P** – **petrol** – checked daily - enough in the car to start your journey and reach service station

- **O oil** checked weekly use dipstick cold engine, level ground, min/max level
- W water checked weekly include coolant and windscreen wash
- **E electrics** checked daily check dash board warning signs and exterior lights

**R** – **rubber** – checked weekly – tyre tread depth should be at least 1.6mm across breadth and around circumference, no bulges or cuts in tyre wall
